

Super Stable Competition

- Competition Outline/Terms and Conditions

The Game/Entry

The Super Stable competition is a free game that can be entered online with a Login/Customer Number and Password on www.hrnz.co.nz to enter. The Super Stable competition is developed and promoted by Harness Racing New Zealand Inc, 135 Lincoln Road, Christchurch 8140.

To enter the competition players must register and complete an entry in full prior to the closing time on (NZ Daylight Saving Time) Thursday 31st August (11.59pm) . The competition concludes at the end of racing on Sunday 31st December 2017.

The Super Stable competition is open to individuals only. Entries received from entities containing multiple individuals (i.e. companies, associations, syndicates, partnerships or similar) will be deemed ineligible.

The competition requires entrants to select 10 horses for their Super Stable. The 10 horses must include two horses from each of the lists (eight in total) and two wildcards.

Each Super Stable is limited to 65 points. Each stable of 10 horses must not exceed this amount of points. If any entry exceeds 65 points it will be disqualified. Entries can, however, be less than 65 points.

Entrants shall select horses from the lists of all eligible horses. Each horse will have a value apportioned to it ranging from 5 to 10 points.

When selecting two-year-olds as wildcards, unqualified horses may be chosen.

Only horses on the lists may be selected for the first eight categories of your Super Stable. Any horse can be chosen for the 'Wildcard' categories.

Australian or international horses are eligible to be selected if they appear on the lists or as wildcards but only when they have either been bred in New Zealand or have had their details input into the Infohorse Database. Entrants are able to search the database to find eligible wildcard horses that are not displayed on any Super Stable lists.

Any entry that fails to provide all required information may be disqualified. HRNZ assumes no responsibility for incomplete, late or wrong entries.

Online entrants will be able to alter their Super Stables an unlimited number of times before the competition close-off after (NZ Daylight Saving Time) 11.59pm on Thursday 31st August.

All entrants will earn virtual dollars as their Super Stable earns virtual stake money. This will apply across the competition with the exception of all races on Sunday December 31 2017 where all stake monies earned will be doubled.

All Super Stables and Super Stable Leaderboards will be updated at the conclusion of every race meeting.

Stakes won in the Super Stable competition relates only to horses finishing in first to fifth position in any official harness race. That is; any race with a total stake value of \$2,000 of more. Stake money won by horses within the Super Stable competition relates to New Zealand races only.

During the last day; Sunday 31 December stake monies earned in any race will be doubled.

Stake money relates to the published stake paid out on any given race as per the www.hrnz.co.nz Internet Site. Stake money does not include any form of bonus that any horse may be eligible for, including Harness Plus Bonuses, racing club incentive bonuses or Sires Stakes bonuses.

By entering and/or participating in the Promotion, each Player agrees to abide by the Terms and Conditions of the HRNZ Super Stable Competition.

Terms & Conditions

The competition is open to New Zealand and Australian residents only.

The competition is open to persons aged 18-years old and over.

The competition is strictly limited to one entry per person.

HRNZ staff members, contractors or Board members and immediate family are ineligible to enter the Super Stable competition. Immediate family for the purposes of this competition includes: spouse (also de facto), parents, children and siblings.

In the event that a player is identified as a minor or as any other person who is in breach of the Super Stable Terms and Conditions, HRNZ reserves the right to refuse to allow the player to take part in the competition, or receive any prizes. HRNZ will notify any relevant regulator where required by law to do so. In such circumstances, the next best entry will be awarded the prize. In the case of a random draw a re-draw may occur.

The promoter complies with the Information privacy principles contained in the Privacy Act 1993. Any entries become the property of the promoter and any information competition players provide will be used by the promoter for the purpose of conducting this competition.

By entering this competition, players consent to their personal information being collected, used and disclosed by HRNZ for the purposes of this promotion.

Players consent includes authorising HRNZ to send the player future electronic correspondence regarding any promotional, marketing and publicity activities.

All players consent to the publication of their name and agree to participate in reasonable promotional activities as requested by HRNZ.

Players have the right to request access to or request correction of his/her personal information.

HRNZ or its employees are not responsible for and shall not be liable for:-

1. Any condition caused by events beyond the control of HRNZ that may cause the game to be disrupted or corrupted.
2. Damages of any kind caused by the prizes or resulting from acceptance, possession, use, or misuse of the Prizes.
3. Typographical errors in any materials associated with the Super Stable Competition.

HRNZ reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to cancel or suspend the Promotion, should the Super Stable Competition be compromised in any way by any virus or bugs in the IT system used for this Promotion, unauthorised human intervention or other causes beyond the reasonable control of HRNZ.

Should any matter not covered by the above conditions arise the ruling decision of HRNZ management shall be final.

Trade Periods.

There will be one trade period during the competition when it will be unlocked and entrants will be able to trade a maximum of two horses. The Trade Window will be Monday 6 November until Wednesday 8 November 2017.

Note: Trades do not take effect until the conclusion of the Trade Window. Therefore, all stake monies earned during the Trade Period by traded horses (in that period) will count towards Super Stable earnings.

Prizes and Notification

First Prize:

The entry that totals the most stake earnings over the period of the competition will receive the following:

- \$1,000 Prezzy Card

Minor prizes:

- 2nd: \$500 Prezzy Card
- 3rd: \$250 Prezzy Card
- 4th: \$150 Prezzy Card
- 5th: \$100 Prezzy Card

- Monthly Winners (leader at the end of September, October, November and December): \$100 Prezzy Card

All prizes offered cannot be varied and cannot be transferred.

Proof of identification may be required in order to claim your prize.

All prize winners will be contacted by phone or in writing using the details supplied in the competition entry.

All prize winners, with the exception of the monthly winners will be announced on Monday 8 January 2018 on www.hrnz.co.nz. The monthly winners will be announced as soon as is practicable following the conclusion of that monthly period.

In the event of a tie for any prize-winning position, the Super Stable with the highest number of first-placed finishes will be placed ahead of any other tied entry. If entries are still tied then a count back on stakes money won by the tied entries will determine the placing.
