RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	XCM SPORT HANDICAP TROT
<p>QUALITY INVASION broke at the start inconveniencing KING OF STRATHFIELD. WHATA GAMBLE broke after 100 metres losing considerable ground. PRINCESS SOPHIA hung outwards through the middle stages. WHATA GAMBLE hung inwards rounding the final bend. BURANO struck several pylons near the 250 metres. WHATA GAMBLE broke with 200 metres to run. KING OF STRATHFIELD trotted roughly in the run home. Authorisation of 4th placing awarded to QUALITY INVASION was withheld until driver G O'Reilly (KING OF STRATHFIELD) had confirmed that his chances had not been affected by QUALITY INVASION breaking at the start. Driver M Jones advised Stewards that he did not activate the removable deafeners on MASTER LAVROS due to having the field covered.</p>	
Race 2	WESTFIELD RICCARTON MOBILE PACE
<p>Trainer N McGrath requested permission to race without the deafeners in place on PEPE BROMAC due to having difficulty inserting them. JUICY ODDS broke racing into the first bend checking FIFTH EDITION. A warning was placed on the racing manners of JUICY ODDS. ISAAC broke briefly passing the 1000 metres when improving three wide. JUICY ODDS raced keenly in the middle stages. ARES hung outwards for the majority of the race. SAGE CREEK struck pylons rounding the final bend. SHADOW RIDER weakened rounding the final bend inconveniencing the trailing GOING TO CALIFORNIA. ARES got its head up and raced roughly under pressure over the final 400 metres. FIFTH EDITION had difficulty obtaining clear racing room through the early and middle stages of the run home. PEPE BROMAC hung inwards early in the run home and had difficulty obtaining clear racing room throughout the run home. JUICY ODDS hung inwards in the run home.</p>	
Race 3	GARRARDS HORSE & HOUND PACE
<p>GERICHO, DAVEY GUNN, SPEEDY JACK and SPECIAL BELLA broke at the start with ULTIMATE CC, FIREBREAK and REVELL YELL being checked by SPECIAL BELLA. A warning was placed on the barrier manners of SPECIAL BELLA. REVELL YELL paced roughly in the early stages. DROVER'S EYRE broke after 100 metres settling at the rear. RANFURLY RULZ broke racing into the first bend. RIVERBOAT PRINCESS gave ground rounding the final bend. TIANA FRANCO and FRANCO HEPBURN were denied clear racing room late in the run home. Driver B Orange briefly dropped his foot from the sulky footrest when activating the sliding blinds on ULTIMATE CC. Authorisation of 2nd placing being awarded to DAVEY GUNN was withheld until Stewards were satisfied that the gelding had complied with the Breaking Horse Regulations when breaking over the early stages. Driver N McGrath (THE FLYING SCOTSMAN) was shown a replay of the run home and warned to change his whip action.</p>	
Race 4	GLENFERRIE FARM NEW ZEALAND 2YO TROTting STAKES (MOBILE)
<p>ROYDON'S JEWEL broke late in the score up losing its chance. MONBET broke near the 1400 metres. When questioned regarding this, driver R May explained that the gelding had been</p>	

racing keenly due to the slow pace and the horse had not reacted as quickly as he had anticipated which resulted in **MONBET** becoming awkwardly placed behind **PRINCE FEARLESS** and breaking.

SPRINGBANK EDEN struck several pylons rounding the final bend when hanging inwards despite the efforts of driver B Williamson. This gelding then broke near the 250 metres.

WANNA PLAY broke late in the run home.

Driver B Williamson (**SPRINGBANK EDEN**) advised that he dropped his whip near the 200 metres.

The all clear was delayed until it could be confirmed that 4th placed **MONBET** had not breached the Breaking Horse Regulations.

Race 5 RESOURCE RECYCLING TECHNOLOGIES NZ LTD MOBILE PACE

CURLIMORE and **RISK** came together in the early stages of the score up with both runners being able to take up their allocated positions.

SUDDEN CHANGE raced keenly in the middle stages.

CURLIMORE hung inwards racing into the first bend.

Trainer N McGrath admitted a breach of Rule 865(1) in that he failed to notify that **CURLIMORE** would be racing with removable deafeners on and was fined \$175 by the JCA.

Stewards ordered a veterinary examination of **POMME ROY** after the colt returned to the stable enclosure with blood present in one nostril. Upon examination by the veterinarian this horse was deemed not to be a bleeder.

Race 6 CANTERBURY STANDARDBRED BREEDERS STAKES (MOBILE)

CRACKAPACA was inclined to hang outwards over the initial stages.

When questioned with regards to the performance of **MAGNA**, driver and co-trainer J Geddes could only advise he had been very disappointed with the efforts of his mare. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

Race 7 MAINEVENT SECURITY MANAGEMENT TROT

DANKE, **YOUNG STRANGER**, **ARMED FORCE** and **IDLE BONES** broke at the start with all these runners losing their chance.

ZHENYA hung inwards when improving to the lead passing the 1700 metres.

HEZA MIGHTY MONARCH broke approaching the 1000 metres.

ZHENYA hung inwards rounding the final bend.

GORILLA PLAYBOY and **MILLICENT** struck pylons passing the 300 metres.

MILLICENT had difficulty obtaining clear running in the early stages of the run home.

SPEEDY EARL was denied clear racing room in the run home.

Driver D Dunn reported that **GORILLA PLAYBOY** sustained a puncture sulky tyre in the run home.

Driver S Ottley (**MILLICENT**) was shown a replay of the run home and warned for the manner in which she shifted ground.

Driver S Golding (**XMAS JOYELLA**) was warned to ensure that his whip remains in the confines of the sulky.

Race 8 BRECKON FARMS & ALL STARS RACING STABLES EASTER CUP (HCP)

JIVIN CULLEN broke at the start.

PEMBERTON SHARD was slow to begin.

DONEGAL'S GUEST and **ADORE ME** paced roughly passing the 300 metres.

Race 9 PENINSULAR BEACHFRONT RESORT MOOLOOLABA MOBILE PACE

Trainer C Dalgety was issued a minor infringement notice under Rule 865(2) in that he presented **A BOY NAMED ROSIE** without the notified sliding blinds and was fined \$100.

THE EMPIRE'S SISTER over-raced in the early stages.

LEWY RISK paced roughly rounding the first bend.

RAESAWINNER raced three wide throughout.

THE EMPIRE'S SISTER gave ground from the 500 metres.

LEWY RISK again paced roughly rounding the final bend.

Driver K Cox (**THE EMPIRE'S SISTER**) reported that she sustained a punctured sulky tyre during the running.

Driver N Rasmussen (**RAESAWINNER**) was shown the replay of the run home and warned to change her whip action.

When questioned regarding the performance of **ALL CASH**, trainer N McGrath advised that the horse had been unsuited to the fast tempo of tonight's race.

Race 10	THE RECRUITMENT NETWORK MOBILE PACE
<p>GOTTA GRUNTER paced roughly as the start was effected.</p> <p>OUR HUGH broke in the early stages checking BOBBY T. Stewards advised the connections a warning would be placed on the gelding's mobile barrier manners.</p> <p>GYRATE hung inwards racing into the first bend placing TOKOHOKA and NULLARBOR NYMPH in restricted room. Driver T Chmiel advised that GYRATE would next race with the assistance of a boring pole.</p> <p>Racing past the 2100 metres GYRATE which was leading eased the pace of the race considerably despite the efforts of driver T Chmiel. The trailing NULLARBOR NYMPH, GOTTA FEELING and BOBBY T all received resulting checks.</p> <p>A warning was placed on the racing record of GYRATE.</p> <p>FRANCO SANCHEZ hung inwards at the 1400 metres which dictated MISSDEBONAIR down the track and into the racing line of NULLARBOR NYMPH which was contacted and subsequently broke for several strides.</p> <p>100 metres after this NULLARBOR NYMPH broke again for a short distance.</p> <p>GYRATE hung inwards on the final turn and struck track pylons.</p> <p>CLEOS A BADGIRL hung inwards on the final turn resulting in NULLARBOR NYMPH racing in restricted room.</p> <p>FRANCO SANCHEZ raced roughly passing the 300 metres.</p> <p>J Dunn (LOVEMETWOTIMES) and C Thornley (GOTTA GRUNTER) briefly dropped their feet from the sulky footrest in the early stages of the run home.</p>	
Race 11	SPECTATORS BAR & BISTRO OPEN 'TIL LATE HANDICAP TROT
<p>REGAL PETITE broke at the start.</p> <p>GIVEN and KINCASLOUGH raced wide in the early stages.</p> <p>VACANZA raced keenly in the middle stages.</p> <p>REGAL PETITE over-raced throughout.</p> <p>GIVEN broke passing the 500 metres inconveniencing the trailing OH NOVA which was held up for a considerable time.</p> <p>MONORAIL broke passing the 400 metres hampering the trailing REGAL PETITE which struck several pylons.</p> <p>KINCASLOUGH broke passing the 200 metres.</p>	
Race 12	BLUE STAR TAXIS MOBILE PACE
<p>CYCLONE KIWI hung inwards rounding the first bend.</p> <p>CYCLONE KIWI again hung inwards rounding the final bend and struck several pylons.</p> <p>A post-race veterinary examination on CYCLONE KIWI revealed no abnormalities. The connections they would have the horse further examined in the upcoming days at which time they will give consideration in sending the horse for a spell.</p>
