RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 **G J GARDNER TROT**

DUCHESSE DE L'AMOUR was fractious prior to the start and broke in the early stages.

TACHMA and **STARLIGHT STARBRIGHT** broke racing into the first bend.

HOPE AND PRAY hung inwards rounding the first bend.

TACHMA, STARLIGHT STARBRIGHT and **DUCHESSE DE L'AMOUR** all broke again in the back straight on the first occasion.

HOPE AND PRAY broke with 1200 metres to run after again hanging inwards.

HENGROEN hung inwards on the bend near the 900 metres and again rounding the final bend.

STRATHMORES CHARM struck a pylon near the 250 metres.

HENGROEN continued to hang inwards throughout the run home. Driver M Williamson reported that he was unable to place the gelding under any significant pressure in the final straight due to the horse trotting roughly and proving difficult to steer.

Race 2 **WASHINGTON VC FILLIES & MARES MOBILE PACE**

MAHINERANGI ROAD over raced in the early stages.

FERNLEIGH HANNAH raced wide rounding the first bend.

BET ON JESS and **NEWMANS JET** briefly locked sulky stays passing the 400 metres.

CANASTA was badly held up rounding the final bend by the tiring **MAHINERANGI ROAD**.

BET ON JESS hung inwards early in the run home.

Race 3 **KEEP IT CLEAN MOBILE PACE**

EXTREMO VELOCIDAD paced roughly and broke checking **PEGASUS KOMMANDER**.

EXTREMO VELOCIDAD was retired from the event. Stewards placed a warning on the gelding's mobile barrier manners.

BEYOND BELIEF raced greenly passing the 2000 metres

GOLDCREST hung inwards passing the 1900 metres and again with 900 metres to race.

LES NORTON over raced and hung inwards in the middle stages.

FANTASY DREAM GIRL hung outwards and over raced for the majority of the event. Driver N Williamson reported that the mare had been striking the sulky wheels and he was of the opinion that she may have choked down. Stewards requested a veterinary examination of this mare which revealed no abnormalities. A warning was placed on the racing manners of

FANTASY DREAM GIRL. Trainer N Williamson advised Stewards that he would be no longer persevering with the mare from his stable.

KOWHAI KING broke near the 550 metres when shifting ground inwards.

LES NORTON gave ground rounding the final bend.

BOOMER BAILEY was held up rounding the final bend and in the early stages of the run home.

BEYOND BELIEF again raced greenly over the final stages.

Driver B Williamson reported that **PEGASUS KOMMANDER** had hung and paced roughly throughout.

HERE COMES MONKEY was cleared from the unruly for future mobile starts.

Race 4 **TIP TOP HANDICAP TROT**

ROYAL SQUEEZE and **HELLAVAHANOVER** broke at the start.

EASY OPTION trotted roughly in the early stages.

Racing into the first bend **ASTRAPI** broke.

Shortly after **XMAS JOYELLA** switched into a pace after being inconvenienced by the breaking **ASTRAPI** and had to be broken up by driver C Thornley.

GLENDALOCH broke passing the 2100 metres.

BONO HEST broke leaving the 1800 metres.
SNOW BOY trotted roughly in the middle stages.
GLENDALOCH again broke with 1200 metres to race.
SARAH PALIN was briefly held up for clear racing room passing the 300 metres.
FEATHER BOYZ had difficulty obtaining clear racing room until late in the run home.
Driver C Ferguson (**SPACE ACE**) reported that he sustained a punctured sulky tyre in the run home.
XMAS JOYELLA was cleared from the unruly for future standing starts.

Race 5 STUNIN CULLEN SPRINT SERIES (HEAT 1) MOBILE PACE

PANIC SLOWLY paced roughly in the early stages and then hung inwards on the first bend striking several pylons.
THE SHAKEY MISTRESS raced three wide without cover throughout.
ALEXY was placed in restricted room late in the run home when racing to the inside of **ROCKIN CULLEN**.

Race 6 SPEIGHTS MOBILE PACE

No claims were lodged in this event.
TUXEDO MAX broke approaching the 400 metres. Driver B Orange advised that the gelding had struck its knee causing it to break. Stewards requested a veterinary examination of **TUXEDO MAX** which revealed no abnormalities.
NEW YEARS JAY broke with 200 metres to run and continued in a break for approximately 80 metres before regaining its correct gait.
SMART CAESAR brushed pylons in the run home.
STRIKE ON COMMAND hung inwards in the home straight.
Stewards lodged a protest under Rule 870(3) and the Breaking Horse Regulations alleging that **NEW YEARS JAY** had broken in excess of 50 metres in the final 200 metres of the race. After viewing several replays, co-trainer/driver J Cox elected not to contest the protest and **NEW YEARS JAY** was disqualified from 1st placing by the JCA.

Race 7 DUNEDIN HOLIDAY PARK PACE

A false start was declared when the barrier strand became entangled around the legs of **RUSSET NORKOTAH**, **THE EDGE OF REASON** and **KATIE PETITE**.
Drivers D White (**RUSSET NORKOTAH**), K Butt (**THE EDGE OF REASON**) and G Shand (**KATIE PETITE**) were warned for the manner in which they addressed the barrier strand when anticipating the start.
KATIE PETITE, **MALDINI** and **JUSTAN'S SISTER** all broke at the start.
HEZ ONLY THE LONELY was slow to begin.
FORGOTTEN RUNNER paced roughly rounding the final bend.
HEZ ONLY THE LONELY had difficulty obtaining clear racing room in the early and middle stages of the run home.
JUSTAN'S SISTER hung inwards in the home straight.
THE EDGE OF REASON hung inwards late in the run home.
When questioned regarding the performance of **CASHEDUP** driver R Close reported that the filly had been striking its knee throughout.
Junior Driver K Butt (**THE EDGE OF REASON**) was shown a replay of the concluding stages and reminded of her obligations to ensure she drives her horse out to the finish of the race.

Race 8 DUNEDIN CITY FORD PACE

VEDIKA and **MCCOVEY COVE** broke at the start.
Stewards investigated a perceived breach of the Push Out Rule with 1100 metres to run after **OASIS DREAM** raced four wide. After viewing the replays it was established that **UNIQUE CHANCE** had commenced its move outwards prior to **OASIS DREAM** reaching its sulky wheel. Accordingly no further action was deemed necessary.
UNIQUE CHANCE gave ground from the 500 metres causing **VERDUN** to be badly held up for some distance. Stewards requested a veterinary examination of **UNIQUE CHANCE** which revealed no abnormalities. Co-trainer G Knight advised Stewards that he would no longer persevere with the horse from his stable.

Race 9 PRYDES EASIFEED MOBILE PACE

Trainer J Burrows was charged a \$25 colour fee for **SEVEN POINT ONE**.
CHIEF KAPAI was slightly back at dispatch.
SEVEN POINT ONE hung outwards in the early stages.

MACH'S LOVE and **SEVEN POINT ONE** over raced in the middle stages.

CHIEF KAPAI was briefly placed in restricted room in the run home by **MAYBE FLYIN**. Driver R Needham (**MAYBE FLYIN**) was shown a replay and advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

SEVEN POINT ONE paced roughly near the 200 metres.

When questioned regarding the performance of **SEVEN POINT ONE** driver D Dunn reported that the mare had been unsuited to the tempo of the race and advised that **SEVEN POINT ONE** had lost momentum when pacing roughly early in the run home.
