

PRACTICAL AND ORAL TEST PROCEDURE WHEN APPLYING FOR A DRIVER'S LICENCE

PROCEDURE

- (1) An applicant who does not hold a Licence To Train or who is not enrolled in the New Zealand Harness Horse Cadet Scheme will not be eligible to sit the Practical Driving Test, except in exceptional circumstances.
- (2) Should an applicant fail the Practical Driving Test, they will be able to take the test for a second time on another day at no extra charge.
- (3) Should an applicant fail the Practical Driving Test for a second time, they may reapply in two months time and pay a new test fee.
- (4) Applicants must supply their own horse at a venue designated by the examining panel which must be a registered racecourse.
- (5) Applicants are required to take the examination at their own risk and sign the "Practical Test Declaration" form to that effect.
- (6) Oral test – All questions to be answered correctly.
