All new applicants to undergo a Practical Test and Oral Test pertaining to the following: -

PRACTICAL TEST

- (1) Catch and Tie Up a Horse for Gearing - A safe approach and adequate tie up.
- (2) Preparation / Pre Checks - of legs, feet, shoes and basic grooming.
- (3) Gearing - Identification and application of gear and assemble.
- (4) Control of Horse and Sulky - Safe release of horse, control of sulky, basic driving skills and drive around track.
- (5) Ungear - Preparation to return horse to paddock / yard / stall.
