AMENDMENT TO HORSEMAN'S LICENCES REGULATIONS - JUNIOR DRIVERS

At its meeting on 6 July 2016, the Board of HRNZ approved changes to the criteria for Junior Drivers within the Horseman's Licences Regulations. This change was to provide additional opportunities for junior drivers who have driven less than 75 winners by giving them an extra season prior to graduation to the open ranks.

Effective for the 2016/17 season, Clause 5(f) of the Horseman's Licences Regulations will read as follows (with changes marked):

"5. Junior Horsemen

The applicant must

...

- (e) *Be under 25 years of age. In exceptional circumstances of which it shall be the sole judge, the Board may licence a horseman for a further season upon reaching the age of 25 years.*
- (f) *Be under 30 years of age and have had less than ~~five~~ six seasons licensed as a junior driver.*
- (g) *Have driven less than 75 winners in races held at totalisator meetings provided that subject to sub clause (e) a Junior Horseman shall be entitled to five seasons as a Junior Horseman regardless of the number of wins achieved.*
