AMENDMENT TO HORSEMAN'S LICENCES REGULATION

On 4 October 2017, the HRNZ Board Special Committee approved an amendment to the Horseman's Licences Regulation, effective 4 October 2017.

The relevant extract from the Horseman's Licences Regulation will now read as follows (with changes marked):

"5. Junior Horseman

The applicant must:

...

(b) Have had a minimum of 25 satisfactory drives as a trials horseman, or be certified by a recognised driving master approved by Harness Racing New Zealand (who shall sign his or her driving record card for each drive) as having completed no less than 10 satisfactory drives at workouts and have had a minimum of 15 satisfactory drives as a trials horseman.

North Island <u>and Otago/Southland</u> workouts are recognised as qualifying experience for an extension to Junior or Graduation horseman, provided a stipendiary steward or Senior Horseman witnesses the drive.
