#### **RACEBOOKS**

Racebooks cost \$5 and will be available for purchase at each of the entrances and from the Racebook marquee located next to the Information Booth.

#### **FOOD**

You may bring your own picnic or food from home however we do not permit commercial food on site. There will be plenty of fabulous food available for purchase in the Public Village and on the Lindauer Lawn for general public and in the Silks Lounge for members.

#### **ALCOHOL**

The course is a fully licensed premises and no BYO alcohol is permitted. Lindauer Lawn and Public bars will commence with a maximum of four drinks per person. Addington management in line with its host responsibility policy will monitor service throughout the day and have the right to decrease this number at any time.

General Admission are the only tickets available to purchase. Presale tickets at \$20 (\$1.50 booking fee) each end on November 12 at 11.59pm. Tickets can also be purchased at all pedestrian entrances for \$30 each. General Admission tickets gives access to the 'Public Village' and temporary grand stand seating along the home straight.

Pass outs will not be permitted.

1. **Zenola Seelster** (E3) Driver: Philip Butcher Trainer: Geoff Small Up tested against this type of opposition & unlikely to make the field.

2. **Caribbean Blaster** Driver: Kate Gath Trainer: Andy Gath Australian visitor who is in grand form. Good beginner who adds interest.

3. **Terror To Love** Driver: Ricky May Trainers: Graham & Paul Court Brings an impeccable build up into this. Looks the one they have to beat.

4. **Major Mark**Driver: Colin DeFilippi Trainer: Mark Purdon
Improved showing in the Kaikoura Cup but the extreme distance is a concern.

5. **Sushi Sushi** Driver: Natalie Rasmussen Trainer: Mark Purdon *His form has been building well towards this run. Eachway claims.* 

6. **Mah Sish** Driver: Anthony Butt Trainer: Tim Butt Recovered well from a recent setback to win last week & longer trip no worry.

7. **Franco Ledger** Driver: Hamish Hunter Trainer: Hamish Hunter Southerner who is absolutely flying at the moment. Primed for this.

8. **Fly Like An Eagle** Driver: Mark Purdon Trainer: Mark Purdon *Produced a devastating late finish at Kaikoura. Big threat if he steps.* 

9. **Stunin Cullen** Driver: Dexter Dunn Trainer: Tim Butt Has yet to recapture his best form this campaign. Look to others.

10. **Mach Banner** (E1) Driver: John Dunn Trainer: Robert Dunn Has struggled against the very best company. Should be safely held.

11. **Pure Power**Driver: Todd Macfarlane Trainers: Dave & Claire McGowan
Improving type but he might find some here a bit smarter. Risking.

12. **Ohoka Texas**Driver: Mark Jones
Trainer: Mark Jones
Not racing well enough to suggest he can trouble this field. Not liked.

13. **Donegal Delight** (E2) Driver: TBA Trainer: Cran Dalgety Competitive against her fellow mares but she is up against it here.

14. **Highview Tommy** Driver: Blair Orange Trainer: Mark Purdon *Proven at the distance & usually a good beginner. Must be included.* 

15. **Gold Ace** Driver: Tony Herlihy Trainer: Steven Reid Class horse who comes into this with a chequered preparation. Win hope at his peak.

16. **Jarcullembra** Driver: David Butcher Trainer: Geoff Small Solid without looking like testing lately. Will need all favours to place.

17. **Pembrook Benny** Driver: Zac Butcher(J) Trainer: Barry Purdon Northerner who was just okay in the Cup trial on Wednesday. Place claims best.

18. **Auckland Reactor** Driver: Maurice McKendry Trainer: Mark Purdon Has had a frustrating Cup preparation & M Purdon has jumped off. Take on trust.



### RACE-BY-RACE PREVIEW

Race 1: Some classy trotters line up here & two of the rising stars could quinella this. Stent (13) and Murcielargo (16) won't stop until they get to the top & both have been set specifically for this race.

Race 2: Mossdale Conner (7) was dazzling winning his graduation heat, coming from near last. He is a quality horse. His big danger appears to be Three Pints (2). Though beaten last Thursday he's got the ideal draw, whereas others haven't feared so well.

Race 3: Thanesan (6) is a big race specialist and his form is better than it reads on paper right now. With Escapee likely to run in the Group 1 the way is clear for him to thrive.

Springbank Sam (3) looked great in his recent trial at Forbury Park, bar an early mistake. He looks to have come back to tip-top order this season.

Race 4: Auckland Cup winner Sir Lincoln (8) has this race by the throat. His fitness is no concern after his setback in October. Easy On The Eye (5) is a great chance to finish right behind Sir Lincoln or test him. He looks back to his best again after a strong trial last week. His gate-speed is a key to the race.

Race 5: All the form points to Jivin Cullen (5). This is an effective drop in class for him after winning the \$50k PGG race at Kaikoura. Betting in this could mean looking for value in behind the favourite. That can come in the form of Phantom Grin (9), La Passione (11), Cam Before The Storm (12) and Hairy Maclary (13).

Race 6: Champion trotter I Can
Doosit (9) chases win 16 in a row.
The punters will plant it on his nose.
Others may be tempted at a gettable
First4. Escapee (10), Leighton Hest (1),
Sovereignty (8) and The Fiery Ginga
(6) appear the keys to that puzzle.

Race 7: Slashing Sires Stakes field.
Anyone who saw Franco Nelson
(3) last time won't want to be on anything else. He's got a great draw to boot. His biggest challenge may come in the form of Arden Rooney (5) who has been tremendous in this first campaign. Those along with Five Card Draw (6) should make up the nucleus of the trifecta and First4.

Race 8: Toughest field of the day. This is a chance to nab a big collect via the exotic bets. The Purdon pair of All Star Man (14) and Highview Teejay (10) may dominate the betting but from their awkward draws they're far from nailed-on winners. The value might lie with Chechnya (7) who is making all the right moves at present and Spectactular (13) who is a great follower of speed up from the deep south.

Race 9: Christen Me (7) appears to be a rising star. He has tremendous stamina and speed to match. Our Boy Sue (1) looks a ready-made quinella from barrier one. He had no luck last time in very tough race. Don't underestimate.

Race 10: How do they beat Terror To
Love (3)? Well, it appears only bad
luck can stop him. If that's the case
who can take advantage of any bad
luck? Gold Ace (15) can – he's always
been an arch enemy of Terror To
Love. Franco Ledger (7) is the stalker
and if he gets the last say he could be
deadly. The fact that Mark Purdon has
hopped off Auckland Reactor to drive
Fly Like An Eagle (8) must be a big tip
too.

Race 11: On exposed form and recent trials Master Lavros (12) appears a standout. He's a beautiful big horse who appears to be peaking nicely. Though Lucky Monarch (10) was well beaten at trials last week by Master Lavros it would be no surprise if he placed at nice odds and made the trifecta worthwhile. Jags Invasion (17) has always had a big reputation.

Race 12: Quality field to finish with and there are chances to get out.

Jason Rulz (1) looks ideally placed from barrier one. He'll get the soft run while many other are butting heads around him. Smiling Star (5) is a smart, durable horse that impressed first-up after a long layoff and Poacher (4) almost won this day last year and will love a race where the pace is on throughout.

### TRIALS TIPS

**Escapee** (R3/R6) looks back to her best. She did everything right & blitzed her rivals at the Cup Trials. She looked fantastic.

**Phantom Grin** (R5) sat parked outside Smolda for the last mile at the Cup Trials & never went away. Based at Tim Butt's for the week he looks a nice bet at odds.

**Five Card Draw** (R7) turned in arguably the best trial at Wednesday's Cup Trials. Big final sections to make ground from the rear against quality opposition.

**Pemberton Shard** (R8) wasn't pushed at trials last week but finished right up behind Elusive Chick & other nice horses. She drops back into this race from a very strong mare's race at Ashburton.

**Statesman** (R9) was another to catch the eye at Cup Trials. He stormed home wide out. Worth remembering too he was nominated for the NZ Cup. No luck in last three starts.

Race 2: Mossdale Conner – he's a really nice horse. Has great speed. Draw a wee worry but a winning chance.

Race 4: Sleepy Tripp — he's a good drive to pick up. He'll need some luck from the draw though.

Race 5: Ellmer Hanover – he's going super right now. He's a good place, provided he doesn't things right.

Race 7: Bettor Rock On – on the ballot & he's had no luck of late. He did well for 4th. He's a runner's chance.

Race 8: Pemberton Shard – nice mare & if she gets the right run she can place, at least.

Race 9: **Ten Diamonds** – it will be tough from this draw & I'd prefer her over more distance but she trialled well the other day.
