

# Dream Team Competition

- Competition Outline/Terms and Conditions



## The Game/ Entry

The Dream Team competition is a free online game that requires players to have a Login/Customer Number and Password on [www.hrnz.co.nz](http://www.hrnz.co.nz) to enter. The Dream Team competition is developed and promoted by Harness Racing New Zealand Inc, 135 Lincoln Road, Christchurch 8140.

To enter the competition players must register and complete an entry in full prior to the commencement of the competition at 11.59pm (NZ Daylight Saving Time) on Wednesday 12 April. The competition concludes at the end of racing on Saturday the 3rd of June 2017.

The Dream Team competition is open to individuals only. Entries received from entities containing multiple individuals (i.e. companies, associations, syndicates, partnerships or similar) will be deemed ineligible.

The competition requires entrants to select 11 horses for their Dream Team. The 11 horses must include one horse from each of the 2017 Harness Jewels categories (nine in total) and two wildcards.

Each Dream Team virtual budget is limited to \$500,000. Each team of 11 horses must not exceed this figure. If any entry exceeds \$500,000 it will be disqualified. Entries can, however, be less than \$500,000.

Entrants shall select horses from the lists of all eligible horses. Each horse will have a value apportioned to it ranging from \$10,000 to \$100,000.

When selecting two-year-olds, unqualified horses may be chosen.

Only horses eligible to race in the Harness Jewels may be selected for the Harness Jewels category of your Dream Team, which means any horse aged two-year-old to four-year-old registered on the HRNZ Infohorse database. Any horse can be chosen for the 'Wildcard' categories.

Australian or international horses are eligible to be selected only when they have either been bred in New Zealand or have had their details input into the Infohorse Database. Invitees from Australia have not yet been picked, therefore some Australian horses are not on the Infohorse Database and will be ineligible. Entrants are able to search the database to find eligible horses that are not displayed on any Dream Team lists.

Any entry that fails to provide all required information may be disqualified. HRNZ assumes no responsibility for incomplete, late or wrong entries.

Entrants will be able to alter their Dream Teams an unlimited number of times before the competition close-off at 11.59pm (NZ Daylight Saving Time) Wednesday 12 April.

Entrants will earn virtual dollars as their Dream Team of horses earn their virtual stake money. This will apply across the competition with the exception of the nine Harness Jewels races where all stake monies earned will be doubled.

All Dream Teams and Dream Team Leaderboards will be updated at the conclusion of every race meeting.

Stakes won in the Dream Team competition relates only to horses finishing in first to fifth position in any official harness race. That is; any race with a total stake value of \$2,000 or more. This includes money earned in PGG Wrightson Yearling Sales restricted races, even though this money does not count to qualifying horses for the Harness Jewels. Stake money won by horses within the Dream Team competition relates to New Zealand races only.

During Harness Jewels day; Saturday June 3 stake monies earned in the nine Harness Jewels Finals will be doubled. Stake money relates to the published stake paid out on any given race as per the [www.hrnz.co.nz](http://www.hrnz.co.nz) Internet Site. Stake money does not include any form of bonus that any horse may be eligible for, including Harness Plus Bonuses, racing club incentive bonuses or Sires Stakes bonuses.

By entering and/or participating in the Promotion, each Player agrees to abide by the Terms and Conditions of the HRNZ Dream Team Competition.

## Terms & Conditions

The Dream Team competition is a free online game that requires players to have a Login/Customer Number and Password on [www.hrnz.co.nz](http://www.hrnz.co.nz) to enter. The Dream Team competition is developed and promoted by Harness Racing New Zealand Inc, 135 Lincoln Road, Christchurch 8140.

The competition is open to New Zealand and Australian residents only.

The competition is open to persons aged 18-years old and over.

The competition is strictly limited to one entry per person.

HRNZ staff members, contractors or Board members and immediate family are ineligible to enter the Dream Team competition. Immediate family for the purposes of this competition includes: spouse (also de facto), parents, children and siblings.

In the event that a player is identified as a minor or as any other person who is in breach of the Dream Team Terms and Conditions, HRNZ reserves the right to refuse to allow the player to take part in the competition, or receive any prizes. HRNZ will notify any relevant regulator where required by law to do so. In such circumstances, the next best entry will be awarded the prize. In the case of a random draw a re-draw may occur.

The promoter complies with the Information privacy principles contained in the Privacy Act 1993. Any entries become the property of the promoter and any information competition players provide will be used by the promoter for the purpose of conducting this competition.

By entering this competition, players consent to their personal information being collected, used and disclosed by HRNZ for the purposes of this promotion.

Players consent includes authorising HRNZ to send the player future electronic correspondence regarding any promotional, marketing and publicity activities.

All players consent to the publication of their name and agree to participate in reasonable promotional activities as requested by HRNZ

Players have the right to request access to or request correction of his/her personal information.

HRNZ or its employees are not responsible for and shall not be liable for:-

1. Any condition caused by events beyond the control of HRNZ that may cause the game to be disrupted or corrupted.
2. Damages of any kind caused by the prizes or resulting from acceptance, possession, use, or misuse of the Prizes.
3. Typographical errors in any materials associated with the Dream Team Competition.

HRNZ reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to cancel or suspend the Promotion, should the Dream Team Competition be compromised in any way by any virus or bugs in the IT system used for this Promotion, unauthorised human intervention or other causes beyond the reasonable control of HRNZ.

Should any matter not covered by the above conditions arise the ruling decision of HRNZ management shall be final.

## Trade Periods.

There will be two periods throughout the competition when it will be unlocked and entrants will be able to trade a maximum of two horses per Trade Window (four trades in all). The Trade Windows are as follows:

- Monday 1 May until Wednesday 3 May (3 Days)
- Monday 22 May until Wednesday 24 May (3 Days)

Note: Trades do not take effect until the conclusion of the Trade Window. Therefore, all stake monies earned during the Trade Period by traded horses (in that period) will count towards Dream Team earnings.

## Prizes and Notification

First Prize:

The entry that totals the most stake earnings over the period of the competition will receive the following:

- \$1,000 Prezzy Card
- A Harness Jewels Merchandise set

Minor prizes:

- 2nd: \$500 Prezzy Card
- 3rd: \$250 Prezzy Card
- 4th: \$150 Prezzy Card
- 5th: \$100 Prezzy Card
- 6th-7th: \$50 Prezzy Card & a Harness Jewels soft-shell jacket
- 8th-9th: \$50 Prezzy Card
- 10th: A Harness Jewels tee-shirt
