# **How To Play**

Harness Racing New Zealand is looking for the sport's best judge of horses and the winner is set for a \$10,000 prize haul.

HRNZ is launching Super Stable 2023 and it will be bigger and richer than any similar competition held in New Zealand before.

The competition lets racing fans, or even newcomers to the sport, select which horses they think will shine brightest over the busy spring racing period. It runs from the start date of October 5 until December 10 and entry is free at <u>www.hrnz.co.nz</u>

Contestants must choose 14 horses for their "stable", 12 of which must be from the lists of horses for each age group provided by HRNZ, with two 'wildcard' selections.

Each horse or wildcard is allocated a value and the combined value of each Super Stable must not exceed \$750,000 - so contestants need to be smart and strategic about which horses they "spend" the most money on.

To make Super Stable even more strategic there will be two trade windows where contestants can add and remove horses, the first after Ashburton Flying Stakes Day (24-25 October) and the other window after NZ Cup week (20-21 November).

The 14 horses each contestant has running for them will secure virtual stake money in line with the money each of their horses win on the track, so a major race win will count for far more than two or three standard race victories.

Only stake money for running in the top 5 in New Zealand races will count.

## **The Prizes**

The prize pool for the Super Stable competition is huge, headlined by a \$10,000 Whitsundays travel package courtesy of the TAB. The prize includes travel, 5 nights accommodation at Hayman Island Resort and \$1,500 credit for meals and activities.

Other prizes are:

**2nd:** A \$5,000 Luxury Queenstown Escape with 3 nights accommodation at The Rees, premium dinner and activities including Gondola, Luge and Onsen Soak.

3rd: A \$2,000 Purepods Getaway

There will also be weekly and monthly winners. The person with most amount of virtual money earned during a week will win a \$50 Bonus Bet, and monthly winners (being the leader at the end of October, and November) will win a \$250 Prezzy Card.

More Prize details are set out below.

### **Terms & Conditions**

#### Entry

The Super Stable competition is a free game that can be entered online with a Login/Customer Number and Password on www.hrnz.co.nz. The Super Stable competition is developed and promoted by Harness Racing New Zealand Inc, Level 1, 17 Birmingham Drive, Christchurch 8140.

To enter the competition players must register and complete an entry in full prior to the closing time on Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> October, 2022 (11.59pm NZT). The competition concludes at the end of racing on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> December, 2023.

#### **General Terms**

The competition is open to New Zealand residents only.

The competition is open to persons aged 18-years old and over.

The competition is strictly limited to one entry per person.

HRNZ staff members, contractors or Board members and immediate family are ineligible to enter the Super Stable competition. Immediate family for the purposes of this competition includes: spouse (also de facto), parents, children and siblings.

In the event that a player is identified as a minor or as any other person who is in breach of the Super Stable Terms and Conditions, HRNZ reserves the right to refuse to allow the player to take part in the competition, or receive any prizes. HRNZ will notify any relevant regulator where required by law to do so. In such circumstances, the next best entry will be awarded the prize. In the case of a random draw a re-draw may occur.

The promoter complies with the Information Privacy Principles contained in the Privacy Act 1993. Any entries become the property of the promoter and any information competition players provide will be used by the promoter for the purpose of conducting this competition.

#### **Competition Terms**

By entering this competition, players consent to their personal information being collected, used and disclosed by HRNZ for the purposes of this promotion.

Players' consent includes authorising HRNZ to send the player future electronic correspondence regarding any promotional, marketing and publicity activities.

All players consent to the publication of their name and agree to participate in reasonable promotional activities as requested by HRNZ.

Players have the right to request access to or request correction of his/her personal information.

HRNZ or its employees are not responsible for and shall not be liable for:-

 Any condition caused by events beyond the control of HRNZ that may cause the game to be disrupted or corrupted.

HRNZ reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to cancel or suspend the Promotion, should the Super Stable Competition be compromised in any way by any virus or failures in the IT system used for this Promotion, unauthorised human intervention or other causes beyond the reasonable control of HRNZ.

The competition requires entrants to select 14 horses for their Super Stable. The 14 horses must include one horse from each of the lists (12 in total) and two wildcards.

Each Super Stable is limited to \$750,000. Each stable of 14 horses must not exceed this amount. If any entry exceeds \$750,000 it will be disqualified. Entries can, however, be less than \$750,000.

Entrants shall select horses from the lists of all eligible horses. Each horse will have a dollar value apportioned to it ranging from \$10,000 to \$100,000.

When selecting two-year-olds as wildcards, unqualified horses may be chosen.

Only horses on the lists may be selected for the first twelve categories of your Super Stable. Any horse can be chosen for the 'Wildcard' categories.

Australian or international horses are eligible to be selected if they appear on the lists or as wildcards but only when they have either been bred in New Zealand or have had their details input into the Infohorse Database. Entrants are able to search the database to find eligible wildcard horses that are not displayed on any Super Stable lists.

Any entry that fails to provide all required information may be disqualified. HRNZ assumes no responsibility for incomplete, late or wrong entries.

Online entrants will be able to alter their Super Stables an unlimited number of times before the competition close-off at (NZ Daylight Saving Time) 11.59pm on Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> October, 2023.

All entrants will earn virtual dollars as their Super Stable earns virtual stake money. This will apply across the competition with the exception of all races on Sunday December 10th, 2023. During the last day; Sunday 10th December stake monies earned in any race will be doubled.

All Super Stables and Super Stable Leaderboards will be updated at the conclusion of every race meeting.

Stakes won in the Super Stable competition relate only to horses finishing in first to fifth position in any official harness race. That is; any race with a total stake value of \$2,000 of more. Stake money won by horses within the Super Stable competition relates to New Zealand races only.

Stake money relates to the published stake paid out on any given race as per the HRNZ website. Stake money does not include any form of bonus that any horse may be eligible for, including Breeding bonuses, racing club incentive bonuses or Sires Stakes bonuses.

By entering and/or participating in the Promotion, each Player agrees to abide by the Terms and Conditions of the HRNZ Super Stable Competition.

Should any matter not covered by the above conditions arise, the ruling decision of HRNZ management shall be final.

#### Trade Periods.

There will be two trade periods during the competition where stables will be unlocked and entrants will be able to trade a maximum of two horses. The Trade Windows will be Tuesday 24th October 2023 until Wednesday 25th October 2023, and Monday 20th November 2022 until Tuesday 21st November 2022

Note: Trades do not take effect until the conclusion of the Trade Window. Therefore, all stake monies earned during the Trade Period by traded horses (in that period) will be those that count towards Super Stable earnings for the period.

#### **Prizes and Notification**

#### First Prize:

The entry that totals the most stake earnings over the period of the competition will receive the following:

Luxury Hayman Island Getaway up to a value of \$10,000 including:

- Return flights from any Major Domestic Airport (Auckland, Christchurch, Dunedin, Wellington)
- Coach / launch ex HTI to Hayman and return.

#### Weekly Winners:

This will be the person with most amount of virtual money earned during that week. If there is more than one person on with the same amount of virtual money earned for the week, a random draw will be used to decide the winner. The prize will be a \$50 Bonus Bet. Players must have a TAB Account to receive this prize. The \$50 Bonus Bet will be deposited into the winner's TAB account on the Thursday of each week.

#### **Monthly Winners**

This will be the leader at the end of October, November. If there is more than one person on with the same amount of virtual money earned for the month, a random draw will be used to decide the winner. The prize will be a \$250 Prezzy Card.

All travel prizes are subject to availability. Where an element of the prize is unavailable it will be swapped for a similar prize of equal or lesser value.

All prizes offered cannot be varied and cannot be transferred or converted to cash.

Proof of identification may be required in order to claim your prize.

All prize winners will be contacted by phone or in writing using the details supplied in the competition entry.

All prize winners, with the exception of the weekly and monthly winners will be announced on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> December on www.hrnz.co.nz. The weekly and monthly winners will be announced as soon as is practicable following the conclusion of that period.

In the event of a tie for any prize-winning position, the Super Stable with the highest number of first-placed finishes will be placed ahead of any other tied entry. If entries are still tied then a count back on second placings, and then third placings will determine the winner. If entries are still tied the winner will be chosen by random draw.

In all other respects, the operation of the competition is the responsibility of HRNZ. In the event that circumstances arise which, in the opinion of the HRNZ CEO, were unforeseen and or uncontemplated by the rules of the competition, the CEO shall have the absolute and final determination as to how to handle the matter.
