Race 1 4YO & OLDER R35 TO R50 MOBILE PACE AMATEUR DRIVERS 2180m
Of \$10000 (\$5500, \$1550, \$950, \$600, others \$175)

For R35 to R50 4yo-&-older pacers. This race is for Amateur Drivers only and has a Preferential Barrier Draw Based on: Rating then Earnings in the last 5 starts using the track grid.

Race 2 R35 TO R39, R40 WITH COND. TROT 2180m
Of \$13000 (\$7150, \$2015, \$1235, \$780, others \$227.50)

For R35 to R39 trotters. Also R40 horses with 1 win for lifetime.

Race 3 R35 TO R41 MOBILE PACE 2180m
Of \$13000 (\$7150, \$2015, \$1235, \$780, others \$227.50)

For R35 to R41 pacers.

Race 4 NON-WINNERS MR40 TO MR44 MOBILE PACE 2180m
Of \$12000 (\$6600, \$1860, \$1140, \$720, others \$210)

For MR40 to MR44 pacers.

Race 5 R45 TO R50, R51 TO R55 WITH COND. MOBILE PACE 2180m
Of \$15000 (\$8250, \$2325, \$1425, \$900, others \$262.50)

For R45 to R50 pacers. Also R51 to R55 if driven by a concession junior driver. Preferential Barrier Draw Based on: Rating using the track grid.

For R35 to R50 4yo-&-older pacers. This race is for Junior Drivers only and has a Preferential Barrier Draw Based on: Rating using the track grid. Rating Penalty Free Race.

Race 9 R50 TO R70 SPECIAL HANDICAP TROT 2700m
Of \$16000 (\$8800, \$2480, \$1520, \$960, others \$280)

For R50 to R70 trotters. Front: R50 to R57. 10m: R58 to R63. 20m: R64 to R70.

Race 10 R50 TO R80 SPECIAL HANDICAP PACE 2700m
Of \$25000 (\$13750 plus Trophy & Dress Rug, \$3875, \$2375, \$1500, others \$437.50)

For R50 to R80 pacers. Front: R50 to R57. 10m: R58 to R65. 20m: R66 to R75. 30m: R76 to R80. This race is included in the COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIP. This race is part of the Southern Cups Series and Country Championship.

Race 11 R40 TO R50 TROT 2180m
Of \$13000 (\$7150, \$2015, \$1235, \$780, others \$227.50)

For R40 to R50 trotters.

Race 12 WITH COND. MOBILE PACE 2180m
Of \$12000 (\$6600, \$1860, \$1140, \$720, others \$210)

For 4 yrs & older pacing mares with 1 to 2 wins for lifetime. Preferential Barrier Draw Based on: Winning Stakes using the track grid. The winner will get a rating penalty free win if 4YO and older, and driven by a Junior Driver, and has not previously won a rating penalty free race this season.

Special Conditions**1. RIGHT OF RE-ENTRY TIME**

Shall be 5pm on day before raceday.

2. ORIGINAL NOMINATIONS

In the event horses are transferred to another race from the trainer, selection preference will be given to original nominations received for that race.

3. IMPORTANT NOTICE TO NOMINATORS

Owners and Trainers are reminded that the club has the right to transfer any horse not selected to start in a race for which it was nominated to ANY OTHER RACE ON THE PROGRAMME for which it may be eligible. If you do not wish the club to exercise its right to transfer a particular nominated horse then it is your responsibility as the nominator to advise the club of the same.

4. SPLITTING FIELDS

In the event any race or races are split on this Programme, unless specific in the individual race conditions, races will be split and selected at the club's discretion, with consideration given to Ratings in the first instance.

5. DUAL ACCEPTORS/NOMINATORS

In the event that horses have gained a start at another meeting these horses are not guaranteed to gain a start at this meeting.

6. GOLD CHIP

For non-win (MR), or up to 1 win trotters for lifetime aged two years and older at the closing of nominations for the Invercargill HRC meeting to be held on Friday 22nd December 2023. Conditions: 1. Open to all trotters aged two years and older that have never won a race (non-winners, MR), or have won one win for lifetime. 2. To be eligible to start in the Gold Chip Championship Trot a horse must start in at least one race or an open trot race run by Southern Harness Racing Clubs (Invercargill HRC, Gore HRC, Central Otago TC, Roxburgh TC, Wyndham HRC, Winton HRC, Northern Southland TC, Forbury Park TC and Riverton TC) in the period from 22nd December 2023 through to 28th January 2024. The 'R' rating horses must win their second respective race at one of the Southern Harness meetings to be eligible 3. Field selection for the Gold Chip Championship will operate as follows: Most wins at a Southern Harness Club meeting during that period, most 2nds at a Southern Harness Club meeting during that period, most 3rds at a Southern Harness Club meeting during that period, then Club Discretion. 4. The \$15000 Gold Chip Championship held on 1st February 2024 at the Invercargill HRC meeting and will be raced over 2700m, from a standing start. (non-winners, MR) will start from the front line, R rated horses from a 20 metre handicap.
