Race 1 NON-WINNERS 3YO & OLDER MR40 TO MR43 MOBILE PACE 1940m
Of \$10000 (\$5500, \$1550, \$950, \$600, others \$175)

For MR40 to MR43 3yo-&-older pacers.

Race 2 NON-WINNERS 3YO & OLDER TROT 2000m
Of \$12000 (\$6600, \$1860, \$1140, \$720, others \$210)

For 3yo-&-older trotters.

Race 3 NON-WINNERS 3YO & OLDER MR45 TO MR50 MOBILE PACE 1940m
Of \$12000 (\$6600, \$1860, \$1140, \$720, others \$210)

For MR45 to MR50 3yo-&-older pacers.

Race 4 R35 TO R50 TROT 2000m
Of \$14000 (\$7700, \$2170, \$1330, \$840, others \$245)

For R35 to R50 trotters. The winner will get a rating penalty free win if 4YO and older, and driven by a Junior Driver, and has not previously won a rating penalty free race this season.

Race 5 R35 TO R39, R40 WITH COND. MOBILE PACE 1940m
Of \$10000 (\$5500, \$1550, \$950, \$600, others \$175)

For R35 to R39 pacers. Also R40 horses with 1 win for lifetime.

Race 6 R51 TO R75 SPECIAL HANDICAP PACE 2800m
Of \$20000 (\$11000 plus dress rug and trophy, \$3100, \$1900, \$1200, others \$350)

For R51 to R75 pacers. Front: R51 to R57. 10m: R58 to R65. 20m: R66 to R75. This race is included in the COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIP.

Race 7 NON-WINNERS 3YO & OLDER FILLIES & MARES MOBILE PACE 1940m
Of \$12000 (\$6600, \$1860, \$1140, \$720, others \$210)

For pacing fillies & mares.

Race 8 R51 TO R85 SPECIAL HANDICAP TROT 2800m
Of \$20000 (\$11000, \$3100, \$1900, \$1200, others \$350)

For R51 to R85 trotters. Front: R51 to R57. 10m: R58 to R65. 20m: R66 to R75. 30m: R76 to R85.

Race 9 R46 TO R55 MOBILE PACE 1940m
Of \$14000 (\$7700, \$2170, \$1330, \$840, others \$245)

For R46 to R55 pacers. Preferential Barrier Draw Based on: Rating numbering sequentially from 1.

Race 10 R40 TO R45, WITH COND. MOBILE PACE 1940m
Of \$12000 (\$6600, \$1860, \$1140, \$720, others \$210)

For R40 to R45 pacers. Also horses with 1 win for lifetime. The winner will get a rating penalty free win if 4YO and older, and driven by a Junior Driver, and has not previously won a rating penalty free race this season.

2. ORIGINAL NOMINATIONS

In the event horses are transferred to another race from the trainer, selection preference will be given to original nominations received for that race.

3. IMPORTANT NOTICE TO NOMINATORS

Owners and Trainers are reminded that the club has the right to transfer any horse not selected to start in a race for which it was nominated to ANY OTHER RACE ON THE PROGRAMME for which it may be eligible. If you do not wish the club to exercise it's right to transfer a particular nominated horse then it is your responsibility as the nominator to advise the club of the same.

4. SPLITTING FIELDS

In the event any race or races are split on this Programme, unless specific in the individual race conditions, races will be split and selected at the club's discretion, with consideration given to Ratings in the first instance.

5. DUAL ACCEPTORS/NOMINATORS

In the event that horses have gained a start at another meeting these horses are not guaranteed to gain a start at this meeting.

6. GOLD CHIP

For non-win (MR), or up to 1 win trotters for lifetime aged two years and older at the closing of nominations for the Invercargill HRC meeting to be held on Friday 22nd December 2023. Conditions: 1. Open to all trotters aged two years and older that have never won a race (non-winners, MR), or have won one win for lifetime. 2. To be eligible to start in the Gold Chip Championship Trot a horse must start in at least one race or an open trot race run by Southern Harness Racing Clubs (Invercargill HRC, Gore HRC, Central Otago TC, Roxburgh TC, Wyndham HRC, Winton HRC, Northern Southland TC, Forbury Park TC and Riverton TC) in the period from 22nd December 2023 through to 28th January 2024. The 'R' rating horses must win their second respective race at one of the Southern Harness meetings to be eligible 3. Field selection for the Gold Chip Championship will operate as follows: Most wins at a Southern Harness Club meeting during that period, most 2nds at a Southern Harness Club meeting during that period, most 3rds at a Southern Harness Club meeting during that period, then Club Discretion. 4. The \$15000 Gold Chip Championship held on 1st February 2024 at the Invercargill HRC meeting and will be raced over 2700m, from a standing start. (non-winners, MR) will start from the front line, R rated horses from a 20 metre handicap.
