## Race 1 NON-WINNERS WITH COND. SPECIAL HANDICAP TROT 2400m

Of \$15000 (\$8250, \$2325, \$1425, \$900, others \$262.50)

Front: Trotters with no wins for lifetime. 20m: Horses with 1 or more wins for lifetime. For horses who were either (MR) non win, or 1-win at time of the Gore HRC Meeting on 27th December 2024, and have raced at a Southern Harness Racing meeting at least once between 27th December 2024 and Sunday 2nd February 2024. See special condition No.6

## Race 2 R35 TO R50 TROT 2400m

Of \$11000 (\$6050, \$1705, \$1045, \$660, others \$192.50)

For R35 to R50 trotters. The winner will get a rating penalty free win if 4YO and older, and driven by a Junior Driver, and has not previously won a rating penalty free race this season.

## Race 3 R51 TO R100 SPECIAL HANDICAP TROT 2400m

Of \$20000 (\$11000, \$3100, \$1900, \$1200, others \$350)

For R51 to R100 trotters. Front: R51 to R57. 10m: R58 to R65. 20m: R66 to R75. 30m: R76 to R85. 40m: R86 to R100.

## Race 4 2YO MOBILE PACE 1609m

Of \$12500 (\$6875, \$1937.50, \$1187.50, \$750, others \$218.75)

For 2-year-old pacers. Preferential Barrier Draw Based on: Sex (fillies drawn inside colts and geldings) using the track grid.

## Race 5 3YO FILLIES MOBILE PACE 1609m

Of \$30000 (\$15000 plus Trophy & Dress Rug, \$4500, \$2400, \$1200, \$900, others \$750)

For 3-year-old pacing fillies. Preferential Barrier Draw Based on: Winning Stakes using the track grid. Group 1 winners or the winners of lifetime stakes of \$100,000 or above are ineligible for this race. Full conditions of this race can be viewed at nzsiresstakes.co.nz.

## Race 6, 7 NON-WINNERS 3YO & OLDER MOBILE PACE 2400m

Of \$12000 (\$6600, \$1860, \$1140, \$720, others \$210)

For 3yo-&-older pacers. This race will be split based on ratings.

## Race 8, 9 R35 TO R55 MOBILE PACE 2400m

Of \$12000 (\$6600, \$1860, \$1140, \$720, others \$210)

For R35 to R55 pacers. This race will be split based on Ratings/Conditions, meaning a higher rating 1-win pacer may be included in a lower rating race. Preferential Barrier Draws will be used if deemed necessary. The winner of the highest rating race will get a rating penalty free win if 4YO and older, and driven by a Junior Driver, and has not previously won a rating penalty free race this season. The stake for the lowest rating race will be \$11,000, middle race \$11,000 and highest race \$12,000.

## Race 10 R51 TO R100 SPECIAL HANDICAP PACE 2400m

Of \$25000 (\$13750 plus trophy and dress rug, \$3875, \$2375, \$1500, others \$437.50)

For R51 to R100 pacers. Front: R51 to R57. 10m: R58 to R65. 20m: R66 to R75. 30m: R76 to R85. 40m: R86 to R100. This race is included in the COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIP. This race is also a part of the Southern Cup Series.

## Race 11 4YO & OLDER MARES UP TO & INCLUDING R70 MOBILE PACE 1609m

Of \$15000 (\$8250, \$2325, \$1425, \$900, others \$262.50)

For up to & including R70 4yo-&-older pacing mares. Preferential Barrier Draw Based on: Winning Stakes using the track grid. For 4yo and older mares rated R70 as at 1st January 2025. See special condition No.7 or see full conditions on the Southern Harness website.

### **Special Conditions**

### **1. RIGHT OF RE-ENTRY TIME**

Shall be 5pm on day before raceday.

#### 2. ORIGINAL NOMINATIONS

In the event horses are transferred to another race from the trainer, selection preference will be given to original nominations received for that race.

#### **3. IMPORTANT NOTICE TO NOMINATORS**

Owners and Trainers are reminded that the club has the right to transfer any horse not selected to start in a race for which it was nominated to ANY OTHER RACE ON THE PROGRAMME for which it may be eligible. If you do not wish the club to exercise it's right to transfer a particular nominated horse then it is your responsibility as the nominator to advise the club of the same.

### 4. SPLITTING FIELDS

In the event any race or races are split on this Programme, unless specific in the individual race conditions, races will be split and selected at the club's discretion, with consideration given to Ratings in the first instance.

### 5. DUAL ACCEPTORS/NOMINATORS

In the event that horses have gained a start at another meeting these horses are not guaranteed to gain a start at this meeting.

### 6. GOLD CHIP FINAL

For non-win (MR), or up to 1 win trotters for lifetime aged two years and older at the closing of nominations for the Gore HRC meeting held on Friday 27th December 2024. Conditions: 1. Open to all trotters aged two years and older that have never won a race (non-winners, MR), or have won one win for lifetime. 2. To be eligible to start in the Gold Chip Championship Trot a horse must start in at least one race or an open trot race run by Southern Harness Racing Clubs (Gore HRC, Central Otago TC, Roxburgh TC, Wyndham HRC, Northern Southland TC, Forbury Park TC, Riverton TC, Invercargill HRC and Waikouaiti TC) and have its second win in the period from 27th December 2024 through to 2nd February 2025 at a Southern Harness Racing Club meeting. 3. Field selection for the Gold Chip Final will operate as follows: Most wins at during that period at a Southern Harness Racing club meeting, most 2nds during that period at a Southern Harness Racing club meeting, then club discretion. 4. The \$15000 Gold Chip Final will be raced over 2400m, from a standing start. Non-win (MR) horses will start off the front. R rated horses off a 20 metre handicap. 6. A horse can only win one Gold Chip Final.

### 7. SOUTHERN BELLE SPEED SERIES

1. Open to all 4 year and older mares up to rating R70 as at 1st January 2025. 2. The heats will be Preferential Barrier Draw based on winning stakes using the track grid. 3. To be eligible to start in the final any mare must have started in a heat of the series. 4. Where a mare is accepted for a heat and that heat is cancelled the mare will be eligible for the final at the discretion of the Club's balloting committee which hosts the final. 5. The winner of a heat will gain automatic qualification for the final. A horse can win two heats and then be ineligible to start in any further heats. 6. Mares will earn points in the heats as follows: 1st - 10 points, 2nd - 5 points, 3rd - 3 points, 4th - 1 point. 7. A minimum of 6 horses will be required for a heat to be run. The highest points scorers in the heats will be selected to start in the final - a maximum of 13 starters - mares with equal points will be selected at the discretion of the club holding the final. Mares selected to start in the final will not be eligible to start in other races on the day of the final.
