**Race 1 NON-WINNERS 3YO & OLDER TROT 2200m (Tentative)**  
Of \$12000

For 3yo-&amp;-older trotters.

**Race 2 NON-WINNERS 3YO & OLDER MOBILE PACE 2200m (Tentative)**  
Of \$12000

For 3yo-&amp;-older pacers.

**Race 3, 4 3YO & OLDER R35 TO R45 MOBILE PACE 2200m (Tentative)**  
Of \$12000

For R35 to R45 3yo-&-older pacers. The winner will get a rating penalty free win if 4YO and older, and driven by a Junior Driver, and has not previously won a rating penalty free race this season. This race will be based on ratings.

**Special Conditions****1. RIGHT OF RE-ENTRY**

Shall be 5:00pm on the day before raceday.

**2. ORIGINAL NOMINATIONS**

In the event horses are transferred to another race from the trainer, selection preference will be given to original nominations received for that race.

**3. IMPORTANT NOTICE TO NOMINATORS**

Owners and Trainers are reminded that the bureau has the right to transfer any horse not selected to start in the race for which it was nominated to any other race on the programme for which it may be eligible. If you do not wish the bureau to exercise its right to transfer a particular nominated horse then it is your responsibility as nominator to advise the bureau of the same.

**4. SPLITTING FIELDS**

In the event any race or races are split on this Programme, unless specific in the individual race conditions, races will be split at the Bureau's discretion, with consideration given to Ratings in the first instance.

**5. DUAL ACCEPTORS/NOMINATORS**

In the event that horses have gained a start at another meeting these horses are not guaranteed to gain a start at this meeting.

**6. GOLD CHIP**

For non-win (MR), or up to 1 win trotters for lifetime aged two years and older at the closing of nominations for the Gore HRC meeting to be held on Sunday 15th February 2026. Conditions: 1. Open to all trotters aged two years and older that have never won a race (non-winners, MR), or have won one win for lifetime. 2. To be eligible to start in the Gold Chip Final a horse must start in at least one race or an open trot race run by Southern Harness Racing Clubs (Gore HRC, Wyndham HRC, Winton HRC, Northern Southland TC, Oamaru HRC, Invercargill HRC and Forbury Park TC) in the period from 15th February 2026 through to 15th March 2026. The 'R' rating horses must win their second respective race at one of the Southern Harness meetings to be eligible 3. Field selection for the Gold Chip Championship will operate as follows: Most wins at a Southern Harness Club meeting during that period, most 2nds at a Southern Harness Club meeting during that period, most thirds at a Southern Harness Club meeting during that period, then club discretion. 4. The \$15,000 Gold Chip Championship held on 19th March 2026 at the Wyndham HRC meeting will be raced over 2400m, from a standing start. (Non-winners, MR) will start from the front line, R rated horses from a 20 metre handicap. Only one Gold Chip Final can be won.
