

First Race Starts: 12:00 noon

Race 1 NON-WINNERS TROT 2400m
Of \$12000 (\$6600, \$1860, \$1140, \$720, others \$210)

In the event there are nine or fewer acceptors for this race, the bureau reserves the right to add the lowest rating out of form 1-win trotters from Race 2 or 3 off a handicap of 30-metres. See special condition No.6

Race 2 3YO & OLDER FILLIES & MARES R35 TO R45 MOBILE TROT 1609m
Of \$11000 (\$6050, \$1705, \$1045, \$660, others \$192.50)

For R35 to R45 3yo-&-older trotting fillies & mares. Preferential Barrier Draw Based on: Rating then Winning Stakes numbering sequentially from 1. The winner will get a rating penalty free win if 4YO and older, and driven by a Junior Driver, and has not previously won a rating penalty free race this season. See special condition No.6

Race 3 R35 TO R45 SPECIAL HANDICAP TROT 2400m
Of \$11000 (\$6050, \$1705, \$1045, \$660, others \$192.50)

For R35 to R45 trotters. Front: R35 to R40. 15m: R41 to R45. See special condition No.6

Race 4 2YO FILLIES MOBILE PACE 1609m
Of \$15000 (\$8250, \$2325, \$1425, \$900, others \$262.50)

For 2-year-old pacing fillies. Preferential Barrier Draw Based on: Winning Stakes numbering sequentially from 1. Where a programmed 2YO race has exactly four (4) acceptors at the close of withdrawals, Harness Racing New Zealand, at its discretion, may elect to proceed with the race and apply a 20% reduction to the advertised stake. In the event this race is not held those horses will be transferred to Race 5 or 7 and conditions altered.

Race 5 NON-WINNERS MOBILE PACE 1609m
Of \$12000 (\$6600, \$1860, \$1140, \$720, others \$210)

For 4 yrs & older pacers with no wins for lifetime with 3 or more starts for lifetime.

Race 6 4YO & OLDER R35 TO R39 MOBILE PACE 2400m
Of \$10000 (\$5500, \$1550, \$950, \$600, others \$175)

For R35 to R39 4yo-&-older pacers. This race will be selected on ratings, lowest to highest.

Race 7, 8 4YO & OLDER R36 TO R45 MOBILE PACE 1609m
Of \$11000 (\$6050, \$1705, \$1045, \$660, others \$192.50)

For R36 to R45 4yo-&-older pacers. This race will be split based on ratings. Preferential Barrier Draws will be used if deemed necessary numbering sequentially from 1. The winner of the highest rating race will get a rating penalty free win if 4YO and older, and driven by a Junior Driver, and has not previously won a rating penalty free race this season. The stake for the lowest rating race(s) will be \$10,000 and highest race \$11,000.

Special Conditions

1. RIGHT OF RE-ENTRY TIME

Shall be 5pm on day before raceday.

2. ORIGINAL NOMINATIONS

In the event horses are transferred to another race from the trainer, selection preference will be given to original nominations received for that race.

3. IMPORTANT NOTICE TO NOMINATORS

Owners and Trainers are reminded that the bureau has the right to transfer any horse not selected to start in a race for which it was nominated to ANY OTHER RACE ON THE PROGRAMME for which it may be eligible. If you do not wish the bureau to exercise it's right to transfer a particular nominated horse then it is your responsibility as the nominator to advise the bureau of the same.

4. SPLITTING FIELDS

In the event any race or races are split on this Programme, unless specific in the individual race conditions, races will be split and selected at the club's discretion, with consideration given to Ratings in the first instance.

5. DUAL ACCEPTORS/NOMINATORS

In the event that horses have gained a start at another meeting these horses are not guaranteed to gain a start at this meeting.

6. GOLD CHIP

For non-win, or up to 1 win trotters for lifetime aged two years and older at the closing of nominations for the Winton HRC meeting to be held on Thursday 26th March 2026. Conditions: 1. Open to all trotters aged two years and older that have never won a race (non-winners), or have won one win for lifetime. 2. To be eligible to start in the Gold Chip Championship Trot a horse must start in at least one race or an open trot race run by Southern Harness Racing Clubs (Winton HRC, Wyndham HRC, Invercargill HRC and Wairio TC) in the period from 26th March 2026 through to 26th April 2026. The 'R' rating horses must win their second respective race at one of the Southern Harness meetings to be eligible 3. Field selection for the Gold Chip Championship will operate as follows: Most wins at a Southern Harness Club meeting during that period, most 2nds at a Southern Harness Club meeting during that period, most 3rds at a Southern Harness Club meeting during that period, then Bureau Discretion. 4. The \$15000 Gold Chip Championship held on 3rd May at the Riverton TC meeting and will be raced over 2400m, from a standing start. (non-winners) will start from the front line, R rated horses from a 20 metre handicap.
