## Race 2 NON-WINNERS 2YO & OLDER MR45 TO MR50 MOBILE PACE 2400m

For MR45 to MR50 2yo-&-older pacers.

#### Race 3 R35 TO R36 MOBILE PACE 2400m

#### Race 4 3YO & OLDER R37 TO R47 MOBILE PACE 2400m

For R37 to R47 3yo-&-older pacers. Preferential Barrier Draw Based on: Rating using the track grid.

### Race 5 R49 TO R60, R61 TO R65 WITH COND. MOBILE PACE 2400m

For R49 to R60 pacers. Also R61 to R65 if driven by a concession junior driver. Preferential Barrier Draw Based on: Rating using the track grid.

#### Race 6 R35 TO R75 SPECIAL HANDICAP TROT 2400m

Of \$13000 (\$7150, \$2015, \$1235, \$780, others \$227.50)

For R35 to R75 trotters. Front: R35 to R40. 10m: R41 to R50. 20m: R51 to R57. 30m: R58 to R65. 40m: R66 to R75. The winner will get a rating penalty free win if 4YO and older, and driven by a Junior Driver, and has not previously won a rating penalty free race this season.

### Race 7 4YO & OLDER MARES R35 TO R60 MOBILE PACE 2400m

Of \$15000 (\$8250, \$2325, \$1425, \$900, others \$262.50)

For up to & including R60 4yo-&-older pacing mares. Preferential Barrier Draw Based on: Rating then Winning Stakes using the track grid.

### **Special Conditions**

#### 1. RIGHT OF RE-ENTRY TIME

Shall be 5pm on day before raceday.

#### 2. ORIGINAL NOMINATIONS

In the event horses are transferred to another race from the trainer, selection preference will be given to original nominations received for that race.

### 3. IMPORTANT NOTICE TO NOMINATORS

Owners and Trainers are reminded that the club has the right to transfer any horse not selected to start in a race for which it was nominated to ANY OTHER RACE ON THE PROGRAMME for which it may be eligible. If you do not wish the club to exercise it's right to transfer a particular nominated horse then it is your responsibility as the nominator to advise the club of the same.

#### 4. SPLITTING FIELDS

In the event any race or races are split on this Programme, unless specific in the individual race conditions, races will be split and selected at the club's discretion, with consideration given to Ratings in the first instance.

#### 5. DUAL ACCEPTORS/NOMINATORS

In the event that horses have gained a start at another meeting these horses are not guaranteed to gain a start at this meeting.

#### 6 GOLD CHIP

For non-win (MR), or up to 1 win trotters for lifetime aged two years and older at the closing of nominations for the Winton HRC meeting to be held on Thursday 8th May 2025. Conditions: 1. Open to all trotters aged two years and older that have never won a race (non-winners, MR), or have won one win for lifetime. 2. To be eligible to start in the Gold Chip Championship Trot a horse must start in at least one race or an open trot race run by Southern Harness Racing Clubs (Winton HRC, Invercargill HRC and Forbury Park TC) in the period from 8th May 2025 through to 6th July 2025. The 'R' rating horses must win their second respective race at one of the Southern Harness meetings to be eligible 3.Field selection for the Gold Chip Championship will operate as follows: Most wins at a Southern Harness Club meeting during that period, most 2nds at a Southern Harness Club meeting during that period, then Club Discretion. 4.The \$15000 Gold Chip Championship held on 17th July 2025 at the Winton HRC meeting and will be raced over 2400m, from a standing start. (non-winners, MR) will start from the front line, R rated horses from a 20 metre handicap.

#### 7. SILK ROAD SOUTHERN WINTER SERIES NO.1

This series will consist of 3 heats and a Final. Heat 1 to be held on 8th May Winton 2400m, Heat 2 22nd May Winton 1609m, Heat 3 2nd June Invercargill 1700m, and Final 12th June Invercargill 2200m. Heats will be held for \$15,000 and Final \$30,000. 1. For mares rated R35 to R60 at the close of nominations for Heat 1 of this series. 2. A horse must have competed in a heat to be eligible to contest a final. 3. Heat Winners are automatic qualifiers. 4. Win two heats and you are ineligible to contest a further heat. 5. Win a heat and a final, the Final will be Rating Penalty Free. 6. Mares eligible for the first heat of the series remain eligible for all further races in this series. 7. Remainder of the field will be selected by the Bureau, with Preference given to horses that competed in the most heats.
