Race 1 NON-WINNERS WITH COND. SPECIAL HANDICAP TROT 2200m

Of \$10500 (\$5775, \$1627.50, \$997.50, \$630, others \$183.75)

Front: 3 yrs & older trotters with no wins for lifetime. 30m: 3 yrs & older horses with 1 win for lifetime. Should there be 9 or more Non-Win acceptors a Non-Win only race will be run.

Race 2 3YO & OLDER R35 TO R45 MOBILE TROT 2200m

Of \$10500 (\$5775, \$1627.50, \$997.50, \$630, others \$183.75)

For R35 to R45 3yo-&-older trotters. Preferential Barrier Draw Based on: Winning Stakes using the track grid.

Race 3 3YO & OLDER R35 TO R69 DISCRETIONARY HANDICAP TROT 2700m

Of \$12000 (\$6600, \$1860, \$1140, \$720, others \$210)

For R35 to R69 3yo-&-older trotters. The winner of the highest rating race will get a rating penalty free win if 4YO and older, and driven by a Junior Driver, and has not previously won a rating penalty free race this season. If sufficient nominations two races may be run. The lower rating race to be run for a stake of \$10,500.

Race 4, 5 NON-WINNERS MOBILE PACE 2200m

Of \$10500 (\$5775, \$1627.50, \$997.50, \$630, others \$183.75)

Races 4 & 5 to be split as determined by the club based on the nominations received.

Race 6 R35 TO R45 MOBILE PACE AMATEUR DRIVERS 2200m

Of \$8000 (\$4400, \$1240, \$760, \$480, others \$140)

For R35 to R45 pacers. This race is for Amateur Drivers only and has a Preferential Barrier Draw Based on: Winning Stakes using the track grid.

Race 7, 8 R35 TO R56, WITH COND. MOBILE PACE 2200m

Of \$12000 (\$6600, \$1860, \$1140, \$720, others \$210)

For R35 to R56 pacers. Also horses with up to 2 wins for lifetime. The winner of the highest rating race will get a rating penalty free win if 4YO and older, and driven by a Junior Driver, and has not previously won a rating penalty free race this season. Preferential barrier draws may apply should it be deemed necessary to ensure overall fairness to all horses given the ratings spread in these races. Ratings and or conditions may be used by the club when determining the splits for these races. The lower rating race to be run for a stake of \$10,500.

Special Conditions

1. RATINGS BASED PROGRAMME

This programme is ratings based. It is a likely indication of the programme that will be in place for the meeting. Where it is required changes will be made to the final programme after the close of withdrawals. Ratings bands and other conditions shown only serve as an indication as to how races will likely be programmed. As nominations permit race conditions will be programmed to ensure horses can race in a competitive environment whilst also optimizing field sizes and where possible ensuring as many horses as possible gain a start.

2. ONE NOMINATION PER HORSE

A horse may only nominate for one race on this programme, the trainer has the right to transfer the horse if he/she wishes, and may advise the club at the time of nomination whether the horse can to be transferred or not.
