Race 1 NON-WINNERS 3YO & OLDER TROT 2400m
Of \$12000 (\$6600, \$1860, \$1140, \$720, others \$210)

For 3yo-&-older trotters.

Race 2, 3 3YO & OLDER R35 TO R54 DISCRETIONARY HANDICAP TROT 2400m
Of \$11000 (\$6050, \$1705, \$1045, \$660, others \$192.50)

For R35 to R54 3yo-&-older trotters. These race will be split on Ratings/Conditions, meaning a higher rated 1-Win horse may be included in the lower rated race.

Race 4 NON-WINNERS 3YO & OLDER PACE 2400m
Of \$12000 (\$6600, \$1860, \$1140, \$720, others \$210)

For 3yo-&-older pacers.

Race 5 NON-WINNERS MOBILE PACE 1609m
Of \$12000 (\$6600, \$1860, \$1140, \$720, others \$210)

For 4 yrs & older pacers with no wins for lifetime. Also 3yo non-win horses with 5 or more starts for lifetime.

Race 6, 7 4YO & OLDER R35 TO R50 MOBILE PACE 1609m
Of \$11000 (\$6050, \$1705, \$1045, \$660, others \$192.50)

For R35 to R50 4yo-&-older pacers. These races will be split on Ratings (highest to lowest). Preferential Barrier Draws will only be applied in the event the spread of Ratings for any given race is deemed too wide.

Race 8 3YO & OLDER FILLIES & MARES R35 TO R50 MOBILE PACE 1609m
Of \$11000 (\$6050, \$1705, \$1045, \$660, others \$192.50)

For R35 to R50 3yo-&-older pacing fillies & mares. Preferential Barrier Draw Based on: Rating then Winning Stakes using the track grid.

Race 9 4YO & OLDER R35 TO R45, WITH COND. MOBILE PACE JUN.DRV 2300m
Of \$11000 (\$6050, \$1705, \$1045, \$660, others \$192.50)

For R35 to R45 4yo-&-older pacers. Also 4 yrs & older horses with 1 win for lifetime. This race is for Junior Drivers only and has a Preferential Barrier Draw Based on: Rating then Winning Stakes using the track grid. Rating Penalty Free Race.

Race 10, 11 3YO & OLDER R35 TO R54 DISCRETIONARY HANDICAP PACE 2400m
Of \$11000 (\$6050, \$1705, \$1045, \$660, others \$192.50)

For R35 to R54 3yo-&-older pacers. These race will be split on Ratings/Conditions, meaning a higher rated 1-Win horse may be included in the lower rated race.

Special Conditions

1. ONE NOM PER HORSE

NOTE: A horse may only nominate for one race on the programme, the trainer has the right to transfer the horse if he / she wishes, and may advise the club at the time of nomination whether the horse is to be transferred or not.

2. DUAL ACCEPTORS

Selection Preference for this meeting, in the first instance, will be given to horses that are not already accepted into a race(s) at another meeting.

3. LATE NOMINATIONS

In the event Nominated are extended for any races or the meeting, selection preference will be given to those horses that Nominated at the original closing time. Except in the case of Non-Win races, where Field Selection Regulations take precedence or where specific race or series conditions are Programmed.

4. ELIGIBILITY

Any horse is eligible to nominate & accept for a race that has a higher Rating than it has. However, preference will be given in the first instance to horses that the race caters for in terms of Rating. Races Programmed with an 'R' rating will see preference given to 'R' rated horses over 'MR' rated horses.

5. FIELD SELECTION

Field Selection for this meeting will be conducted in line with the Handicapping Regulations for non-win or non-win front races. That being; first and second preference horses will be selected in the first instances and thereafter at club's discretion. All other races will be selected at the club's discretion or per the conditions attached to each Programmed race.

6. SPLITTING FIELDS

In the event any race or races are split on the Programme, unless specific in the individual race conditions, races will be split and selected at the club's discretion, with consideration given to Ratings in the first instance.
