Race 1 NON-WINNERS WITH COND. SPECIAL HANDICAP TROT 2400m

Of \$15000 (\$8250, \$2325, \$1425, \$900, others \$262.50)

Front: Trotters with no wins for lifetime. 20m: Horses with 1 or more wins for lifetime. For horses who were either (MR) non-win or 1-win at time of the Gore HRC meeting on 26th September 2024, and have raced at a Southern Harness meeting at least once between 26th September 2024 and 31st October 2024. See special condition No.6

Race 2 R35 TO R70 SPECIAL HANDICAP TROT 2400m

Of \$12000 (\$6600, \$1860, \$1140, \$720, others \$210)

For R35 to R70 trotters. Front: R35 to R40. 10m: R41 to R50. 20m: R51 to R57. 30m: R58 to R65. 40m: R66 to R70. The winner will get a rating penalty free win if 4YO and older, and driven by a Junior Driver, and has not previously won a rating penalty free race this season. If sufficient nominations this race will be split based on Ratings/Conditions, meaning a higher rated 1-win horse may be included in a lower rated race. The stake of the lowest rating race will be \$10,000.

Race 3 NON-WINNERS 2YO MOBILE PACE 1609m

Of \$11000 (\$6050, \$1705, \$1045, \$660, others \$192.50)

For 2-year-old pacers. Preferential Barrier Draw Based on: Sex (fillies drawn inside colts and geldings) using the track grid. In the event this race is not run those remaining acceptors will become eligible for & transferred to Races 5 or 6.

Race 4 3YO UP TO & INCLUDING R55 MOBILE PACE 1609m

Of \$12000 (\$6600, \$1860, \$1140, \$720, others \$210)

For up to & including R55 3-year-old pacers. Preferential Barrier Draw Based on: Rating using the track grid. If this race is not held, these horses will be transferred to races 8 and 9 and conditions changed.

Race 5 NON-WINNERS 3YO & OLDER FILLIES & MARES MOBILE PACE 2400m

Of \$12000 (\$6600, \$1860, \$1140, \$720, others \$210)

For 3yo-&-older pacing fillies & mares. In the event Race 3 is not run those remaining filly acceptors will become eligible for & transferred to this race.

Race 6 NON-WINNERS 3YO & OLDER COLTS & GELDINGS MOBILE PACE 2400m

Of \$12000 (\$6600, \$1860, \$1140, \$720, others \$210)

For 3yo-&-older pacing colts & geldings. In the event Race 3 is not run those remaining colt or gelding acceptors will become eligible for & transferred to this race.

Race 7 R35 TO R45 WITH COND. MOBILE PACE 1609m

Of \$11000 (\$6050, \$1705, \$1045, \$660, others \$192.50)

For R35 to R45 pacing fillies & mares. Preferential Barrier Draw Based on: Rating then Winning Stakes using the track grid. The winner will get a rating penalty free win if 4YO and older, and driven by a Junior Driver, and has not previously won a rating penalty free race this season.

Race 8, 9,10 R35 TO R65 WITH COND. MOBILE PACE 2400m

Of \$12000 (\$6600, \$1860, \$1140, \$720, others \$210)

For R35 to R65 4 yrs & older pacers. Also R56 to R65 3yo horses. These races will be split by Ratings/Conditions, meaning a higher rating 1-Win pacer may be included in a lower rating race. Preferential Barrier Draws (on Rating) will be used if deemed necessary. The stake for the lowest rating race will be run for \$10,000, middle race(s) \$11,000 and highest race \$12,000.

Special Conditions

1. RIGHT OF RE-ENTRY TIME

Shall be 5pm on day before raceday.

2. ORIGINAL NOMINATIONS

In the event horses are transferred to another race from the trainer, selection preference will be given to original nominations received for that race.

3. IMPORTANT NOTICE TO NOMINATORS

Owners and Trainers are reminded that the club has the right to transfer any horse not selected to start in a race for which it was nominated to ANY OTHER RACE ON THE PROGRAMME for which it may be eligible. If you do not wish the club to exercise it's right to transfer a particular nominated horse then it is your responsibility as the nominator to advise the club of the same.

4. SPLITTING FIELDS

In the event any race or races are split on this Programme, unless specific in the individual race conditions, races will be split and selected at the club's discretion, with consideration given to Ratings in the first instance.

5. DUAL ACCEPTORS/NOMINATORS

In the event that horses have gained a start at another meeting these horses are not guaranteed to gain a start at this meeting.

6. GOLD CHIP FINAL

For non-win (MR), or up to 1 win trotters for lifetime aged two years and older at the closing of nominations for the Gore HRC meeting held on Thursday 26th September 2024. Conditions: 1. Open to all trotters aged two years and older that have never won a race (non-winners, MR), or have won one win for lifetime. 2. To be eligible to start in the Gold Chip Championship Trot a horse must start in at least one race or an open trot race run by Southern Harness Racing Clubs (Gore HRC, Wyndham HRC, Northern Southland TC, Oamaru HRC, Invercargill HRC, Tuapeka HRC and Winton HRC) and have its second win in the period from 26th September 2024 through to 31st October 2024 at a Southern Harness Racing Club meeting. 3. Field selection for the Gold Chip Final will operate as follows: Most wins at during that period at a Southern Harness Racing club meeting, most 2nds during that period at a Southern Harness Racing club meeting, then club discretion. 4. The \$15000 Gold Chip Final will be raced over 2400m, from a standing start. Non-win (MR) horses will start off the front. R rated horses off a 20 metre handicap. 6. A horse can only win one Gold Chip Final.
