PRACTICAL TEST

- (1) Catch and Tie Up a Horse for Gearing A safe approach and adequate tie up.
- (2) Preparation / Pre Checks of legs, feet, shoes and basic grooming.
- (3) Gearing Identification and application of gear and assemble.
- (4) Control of Horse and Sulky Safe release of horse, control of sulky, basic driving skills and drive around track.
- (5) Ungear Preparation to return horse to paddock / yard / stall.
